

CLAUSE 01 - OBJECT

The Object of this Amendment remains unchanged, being detailed in clause 02 of the contract 70200/19-04/00.

CLAUSE 02 - APPLICABLE LAW

It is an amendment, based on item II of article 57, combined with article 123 of Law No. 8666, of June 21, 1993, as it is a service to be performed continuously.

CLAUSE 03 - PRICE

3.1 The price of the services, contained in clause 9.1 were renegotiated, for the economic and financial adequacy of the contract, with the table in Annex B of Contract 70200/20-04/02 being replaced by the table detailed in Clause 3.3 of this Amendment.

3.2 As a result of the economic-financial adequacy of the contract, the estimated amount in clause 9.3 is changed to USD 53,933.66.

CLAUSE 04 - Liquidated Damages

4.1 The Clause 16.1 is now in effect with the following wording: In the event that Seller exceeds the delivery time for more than 50 (fifty) days from receipt of an ocean request from BNC or Seller delivers nonconforming services in accordance with Ibis Contract, and such failure is not excused pursuant to Clause 8.1 - Excusable Delays, Buyer shall be entitled to collect damages from Seller for the delay in delivery at the daily rate of 0.5% of the Freight Charges specified in the Seller's Price Proposal. For each day until confirming service is delivered to Buyer, provided that such liquidated damages shall not exceed 18% of the price for the service specified in this Contract. Reimbursement shall be made through a check made to BNC or deducted from future payments.



4.2 For air transport, the delivery period is 10 days.

4.3 The time for the delivery of the items starts upon receipt of the shipment request, being computed until the effective delivery of the items in Brazil.

CLAUSE 05 - TERM



CLAUSE 6 - FINAL DISPOSITIONS




