Amendment n.1 (Contract 70200/24-07/02)

Amendment n.1 to Contract No. 70200/24-07/01, executed between the Brazilian Naval Commission in Washington and USI Insurance Services LLC, for the provision of health insurance services including medical, dental, and vision coverage for Local Hired Employers and Federal Employes of the Brazilian Naval Commission in Washington (BNCW) and the Brazilian Naval Attaché in the United States of America.

The Brazilian Federal Government, through the Brazilian Naval Commission in Washington (BNCW), Brazilian Navy, located at 5130 MacArthur Blvd., N.W., Washington, DC, 20016, represented herein by his President, **CAPTAIN HUGO MARTORELL RODRIGUES GARCIA**, appointed by Directive No. 101, from May 8, 2024, ID n° 5015-6245-50, hereinafter referred to as **BUYER**, and the company **USI INSURANCE SERVICES LLC**, represented by **DAVID MASRI**, holder of the Driver's License n° A69631158, with main offices located at 3190 Fairview Park Drive, Suite 400, Falls Church, VA, 22042 hereinafter referred to as **SELLER**, in view of what is stated in Process n° 63150.000493/2024-60, in compliance with the provisions of Regulation GM-MD No. 5.175, of December 15, 2021, adapted to local peculiarities, hereby agree to execute this Amendment to Contract n° 70200/24-07/01, under the following clauses and conditions:



CLAUSE ONE - OBJECT

1.1 This amendment aims to financially adjust the redistribution of the number of employees (Local Hired Employees and Federal Employees) among the four groups specified in item 1.1 of the Terms of Reference.

1.2 Additionally, for contractual support purposes, the possibility of changes in the family composition of the groups was considered, allowing for a redistribution of the associated headcount by up to 10% (ten percent) of the total number of Local Hired Employees (LHE) and Federal Employees (FE) by the end of the contract's term.

1.3 The unit values for each group and the total number of LHE and FE (23 people) remain unchanged.

CLAUSE TWO - PRICE

2.1 The total amount of this Amendment is up to USD 30,054.04 (thirty thousand, fifty-four US dollars and four cents).

2.2 Following the reference value adjustment, the estimated total annual amount of the ORIGINAL CONTRACT will increase from USD 473,809.00 (four hundred seventy-three thousand, eight hundred nine US dollars) to USD 503,863.04 (five hundred three thousand, eight hundred sixty-three US dollars and four cents), including all contractual costs and expenses, while maintaining unchanged the unit prices and the total number of employees.

2.3 The above amount is merely an estimate, and payments due to the SELLER will depend on the actual number of covered members and their respective group classifications, as defined in the plan's structure.

2.4 The monthly amount due under this contract shall be adjusted based on the actual enrollment figures and the allocation of beneficiaries among the coverage categories.

3.2 To cover the projected expense, Commitment Note No. 2025NE213034, dated 02/26/2025, was issued in the amount of USD 58,000.00 (fifty-eight thousand US dollars), without prejudice to the issuance of additional funds or cancellations due to budget availability, changes in the PTRES, or new legal requirements.

CLAUSE FOUR - EFFECTIVE DATE

4.1 This amendment shall take effect as of April 28th/2025.

CLAUSE FIVE - RATIFICATION

5.1 All other provisions and conditions of the original contract that are not in conflict with this amendment are hereby maintained and ratified.

CLAUSE SIX - PUBLICATION



6.1 It shall be the responsibility of the BUYER to disclose this instrument by arranging for its publication in accordance with the applicable legislation.
