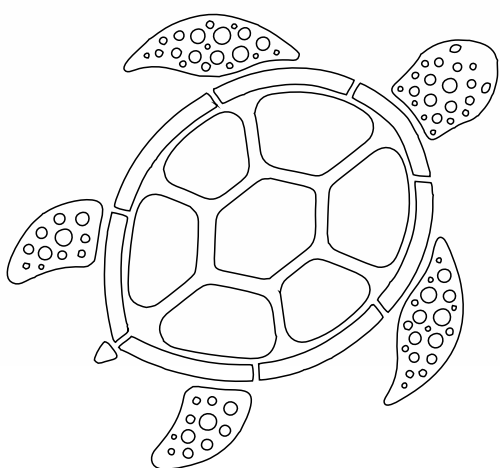


ABOUT US

The Environmental Superintendence of the Directorate of Ports and Coasts is responsible for fulfilling the tasks attributed to the Brazilian Maritime Authority (AMB) with regards to the prevention of environmental pollution caused by ships, platforms and their support facilities.

In addition to these tasks directly related to the AMB, DPC, as the Brazilian Navy Technical Directorate on environmental management, is responsible for Leading the implementation of the Environmental Management System (SGA) within the Military Organizations (OM) of the MB, which activities may cause environmental pollution, mainly as a consequence of oil discharge.



ENVIRONMENT

The following activities are developed by the Environmental Superintendence



- Issues technical reports cooperating for the exchange of environmental protection information with bodies and entities of the Brazilian maritime Community and corporates, as well with international organizations;



- Takes part in collegiate bodies government and non government work groups about maritime environment protection , of navy interest;



- Composes the evaluation and monitoring group of the National Contingency Plan, according to Decree 10.950/2022;

- Elaborates Environmental Technical Reports related to oil spills and its derivatives in Brazilian Jurisdictional Waters, as demanded by the Brazilian Law.



- Establishes requirements regarding the prevention of pollution by vessels; the management of ship ballast water; and on control of the use of anti-fouling systems that are harmful to the marine environment and human health.
